- **Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams – Quorum Status**
  - **Approved**
  - **Interim Deputy Chairman – Had to come a little late, but on roll call.**
- **Interim Secretary moderated the meeting – Please start the recording.**
- **Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams – A Quorum is formed. Welcome to an official meeting of The Great Council of the ANTU, a sub-union of the American National Union of The United States of America. During announced discussion time on each point of order and after the meeting has ended and recording is turned off, we will take questions, so write them down or put in chat if you desire. You can raise your hand in the chat room and you will be recognized. When finished lower your hand. The hand is at the bottom of whose present in the room if you are new.**
- **Interim Secretary– John Mark Adams – Now for Roll Call: Please state your first and last name clearly. If you think you were not heard, repeat your name for the recording.**

- **Called for Office Holder Reports**

- **Interim Chairman – Sean Beller**

- **An Interim Chair meeting was held for officers only today. The meeting went well.**
- **The permission request to do vetting for the ANU Transportation Administration applications by the ANTU has been withdrawn, and will be announced by Deputy Chair/Liaison to the ANU at the next convening on 6/18/2019.**
- **A motion to withdraw the above was put on the floor for approval.**
  - **No discussion was given, a second was given by Mark Fain. The motion passes and carries.**
- **The ANU Transportation Administration is dividing vetting questions on Public and Commercial to two teams of individuals within the ANU who hold**

**no office in the ANU within the team structure. Some of the members of the ANTU are also an ANU member, and will help in the commercial vetting questions to send back to John Mark Adams, Trustee for final approval as will the Public Team for vetting questions, before a final decision is given and send to Johnny Rowe for completing an order to process. Accountability steps are in this process to remain transparent and held to the highest standard. In other words no one putting forth 'an order' can vet their own order and send to Johnny Rowe. The overall Project Team will review as needed.**

- **Things have slowed down somewhat in the ANTU.**
- **The ANTU is looking for recognition by US, Inc. to the Secretary of the DOT.**
- **Sean Beller motions to start a second night of A.N.T.U. assembly then committee meeting as an additional on Wednesday evenings at 6 pm EST.**
  - **The motion was seconded by James O'Neill, and then it was passed and carried.**
  - **After the meeting the updates on the ANTU web page and other places within the ANU have been updated to meet at 6 pm, not 8pm so all could make the meeting.**
- **Sean Beller asked that the letter going to the US, Inc. Secretary of DOT be brought up on Screen**

**Share. John Mark Adams, Trustee was ask to read to the assembly one time.**

- **‘The point that the 1789 government is not a government’. It was checked and there were no error with this verbiage.**
- **A motion was put forth by Sean Beller to send forward this letter to the US, Inc. Secretary of the DOT when returned by the International Notary. When the letter is returned by International Notary. Sean Beller will date and send this letter by Registered/Certified mail for a receipt to be returned with a signature proving delivery and receiving. This will be mailed through their union to send it as this time. Then John Fulks is to be alerted so he can send to the D.O.D, and then publish in the American Herald, and the ANTU Web Page and anywhere else an ANTU officer would feel a need to publish. There was no discussion; James O’Neill gives a second to the motion, the motion passes and carries.**
  - **The tracking number can be used to track on line for the proof as well.**
  - **The US, Inc. DOT Secretary’s name is pronounced Chow, but spelled different.**
- **Interim Treasurer report – Mark Fain**
  - **Had talk with Keith Edward Livingway, PMA on business units of energy.**

- **Looking forward to some huge work yielding a great return to help out with ANTU and ANU.**
- **Also need to revisit commodities exchange and all the steps in that.**
- **CBD oils that Mark is involved in is in process, and is being tested in the market place now.**
- **Danny Barron commented that deregulation is coming to CBD oils. He said he hear Sen. McConnell from US, Inc. was behind the deregulation, as he is in the CBD business.**
  
- **Interim Deputy Chairman – James O’Neill**
  - **Brief Report**
    - **An outreach to Firearms dealers has been done.**

    - **James O’Neill did have one motion to make.**
      - **The motion was made to let be known that the officers are interim. - **A Fraud Group/alert was put in the ANU web site to join to get alerts on fraud attempts or scams to be aware of across our metes and bounds.**
- **All updates have been made on the ANTU web site with correct verbiage. The insertion of the changes into the By-Laws will come soon. It will go where 'amendments' in the By-Laws are.**

- **The minutes for May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to date were gone over and approved by the assembly. Affixing signatures were approved and to publish.**
- **It was reminded to the assembly by Deputy Chairman that if anyone sees is wrong, or needs a correction please speak up so it can be changed or make an amendment to show the change outside the original minutes.**
- **Affixing signatures of Chairman and Deputy Chairman was given for previous minutes reviewed.**

- **New business:**

- **Deputy Chairman O'Neill said that a Network should be set up to help all ANTU members stay active in having work and loads to carry, etc...**
- **This would help draw people in to the ANTU.**
- **A discussion was held to get a website to be set up with a link in the ANTU site to refer to in this area.**

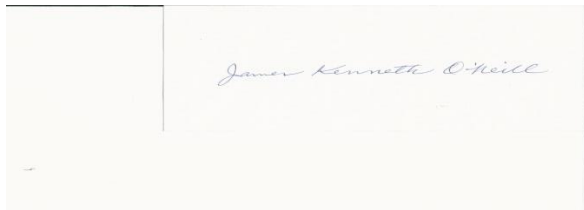
