- **Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams – Quorum Status**
 - **Approved**
- **Interim Secretary moderated the meeting – Please start the recording.**
- **Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams – A Quorum is formed. Welcome to an official meeting of The Great Council of the ANTU, a sub-union of the American National Union of The United States of America. During announced discussion time on each point of order and after the meeting has ended and recording is turned off, we will take questions, so write them down or put in chat if you desire. You can raise your hand in the chat room and you will be recognized. When finished lower your hand. The hand is at the bottom of those present in the room if you are new.**
- **Interim Secretary– John Mark Adams – Now for Roll Call: Please state your first and last name clearly. If you think you were not heard, repeat your name for the recording.**

- **Those present at meeting are as follows.**

- **Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams**

- **Called for Office Holder Reports**

- **Interim Chairman – Sean Beller – Showed a video on HTI or B1/B2 Visa’s and immigration using them for work.**

- **Showed US, Inc. President Trump talking about leveling the playing field.**
- **Philippines are the largest country that comes to America with the Visa’s.**
- **The kind of work can be trainers, supervisors, skilled workers, execute a contract, like this.**
- **Show American workers losing out because they do not have access to these jobs.**
- **The US, Inc. law makers have little knowledge of what is happening.**
- **Lack of transparency, and they take the place of American Truckers. Beth Cornett affirmed that they are taking the Truckers positions and trash**

places. Sean Beller says they plan to buy the property later. These workers are in a different jurisdiction.

- **Sean is still working on getting in contact with OIDA to be a member of the ANTU.**
- **Sean stated that James O'Neill did nothing wrong at the ANU meeting. He apologized if anyone thought it was intended for James. It was not.**

- **Interim Treasurer report – Mark Fain**
 - **Not able to attend this meeting. No report available.**

- **Interim Deputy Chairman – James O'Neill**
 - **Mentioned to Sean his tone came across not so good. It was not intended for James, but just making sure the messages were coming across correctly.**
 - **The report given at the A.N.U. was as follows.**
 - **The A.N.T.U. Chairman has withdrawn a motion for ANTU to vet commercial operators and equipment outside of A.N.T.U.**
 - **A.N.T.U. is pursuing OIDA for the purpose of joining A.N.T.U. as a franchise and given protection anywhere they work**
 - **Johnny Rowe withdrew his objection as well.**

- **James report contained information about continuing outreach to other companies in trucking.**

- **Interim Secretary - John Mark Adams**
 - **Motion was made to table the 'Hold Harmless' document. The reason is the protection is already there, thus not needed per Post Master Council.**
 - **Interim Chairman Beller brought up the fact that the 'Hold Harmless' document actually needs to be tabled till a talk is done with the P.M.C., and or re-worked so it can be presented to the P.M.C.**
 - **Interim Secretary John Mark Adams brought up the document to screen share.**
 - **Questions were answered on who it protects in the whole circumstances of who joins the A.N.T.U.**
 - **Sean Beller in retrospect says that it needs to stand till the A.N.T.U. is able to represent to the P.M.C.**
 - **The motion was made to leave membership and 'Hold Harmless' document/links in place till a meeting with the P.M.C. takes place. As of a later date, John Mark Adams was able to re-connect the links of 'Hold Harmless' for now until A.N.T.U. interim chairs can meet with P.M. General.**
 - **A note to remember: We have to codify our By-Laws. It will be a chore, but needs to be done.**

- **Sean Beller asked that he be e-mailed the Safety Doc to our By-Laws so he can begin to work on it to bring back and show progress to the assembly.**
 - **James recommended to work on a definition to support the Table of Contents already done. James O'Neill asked for a copy of the e-mail to.**
 - **Reminder: To establish a Hotline # for people in the A.N.T.U. to call when in trouble. [At this time in writing the minutes, this # has been established to allow John Mark Adams will take call and forward to the other three officers, thus at no cost, and published in the A.N.T.U. web site. The A.N.T.U. will take a call and come together as interim officers, and look at the problem at this time and put forth a plan.] The motion was made, and seconded by Sean Beller to pursue this and establish. Motion passed and carried.**
 - **It was recommended that someone from P.A.G.A.A. be assigned to assist the A.N.T.U.**
 - **Also reported was that a donation page inserted to the A.N.T.U. web page.**

 - **Motion brought forth to bring the opportunity for PAGAA to have Johnny Rowe appoint himself or someone to help the ANTU. The ANTU liaison was**

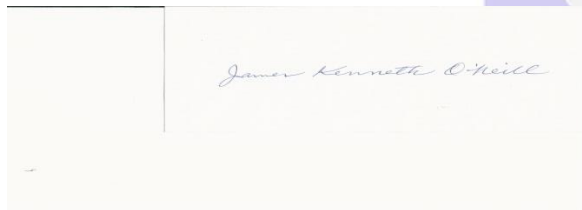
