- **Interim Administrator/Secretary – Opening comments**

- **John Mark Adams reports on updates to assembly and help still needed.**
- **Oath and affirmations are required for three people, Carter Grant, Yolonda Thompson, and James O’Neill.**
- **The documents that have been gone over so far show some to be very long, and need to be gone over in committee.**
- **The Registrar and Office of Deeds and Recordings need to provide us an e-mail or start one with the General Post Office so the right communication goes to the right office.**
- **A video was played on ‘a perspective’ from those in the trucking industry to show or highlight problems that are pervasive across this industry. This was shown for dealing with those on the commercial side that will come through the A.N.U. Transportation Administration.**
