- **Hosted by Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams this meeting. What is the Quorum Status?**

- **Interim Deputy Chairman O’Neill – Please start the recording**
- **Interim Secretary – A Quorum is formed. Welcome to an official meeting of The Great Council of the ANTU, a sub-union of the American National Union of The United States of America. - **This week Sean Beller received negative comments on the growth of the A.N.T.U. James said he shared in that remark with Sean, as he is not alone.**
- **Interim Secretary Adams comments that growth over 4 months plus some days has actually been good considering there has not been a Trucking Union before.**

- **Interim Secretary - John Mark Adams**
  - **Shared Screens to show the latest update of the A.N.T.U. Business Certificate. It is still being worked on for as perfect as it can get.**
  - **A motion was passed to use WORD to update A.N.T.U Business Certificates, business card, and membership card. The motion passed and carried.**
  - **No minutes to share at this meeting due to overwhelming work load on John Mark Adams part.**
  - **All were reminded where to sign up for membership.**

- **Interim Chairman – Sean Beller –**

- **Motion on the floor – 1<sup>st</sup> of two motions**
  - **Any office holder, or assembly member confronted with claims of liability of any other office holder or assembly member, shall immediately contact all other office holders in the A.N.T.U., and chairman shall call an emergency convening with the people, person(s) bringing claim invited. If the claimant fails to attend, the claim shall be considered invalid.**
  - **Proper notice must be given. There shall be 72 hours given to convene in an emergency meeting in the ANTU Zoom Room # 2669584186, or in Zoom Room # 766-499-0966.**

- **To guarantee right of defense, an office holder not accused of liability shall moderate conference insuring proper rebuttal.**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Motion**
- **The convening of this Union shall convene before being considered in trust or being dissolved, and all office holders must vote unanimously before a change of status can be valid.**

**Restated of the consideration of putting the A.N.T.U. back in trust or dissolved:**

**The Officers of the American National Trucking Union must convene before being considered placed in trust or being dissolved, and all Officers must vote unanimously before a change of status can be valid, with the option of recording this motion in any and all publications of record.**

- **These were two motions after careful thought and discussion. The motions were both seconded.**
- **The motions passed and carried.**
- **It is now to be published, and put in our by-laws as required.**

- **New Business**
  - **Question: Is there alternative ways to run trucks on hydrogen? Research is being conducted after the question**
  
- **Motion on the floor by Sean Beller:**
  - **The A.N.T.U. meeting on Wednesday will be remaining in committee, unless there is a situation that needs to have an assembly called.**
  
- **The motion was discussed, seconded and passed.**
  
- **Motion on the floor by Sean Beller in two parts: There shall be an immediate disqualification for life of a commercial truck driver with their first heart attack, pending a physician review and report of approval showing no threat of driving would be a liability. Their membership remains the same; they are just disqualified from operating commercial equipment. They must report this immediately to the A.N.T.U.**
- **If a commercial truck driver reports the intravenous need to take diabetic medicine they are disqualified for life, unless their condition were to improve and they are able to go to oral diabetic medicine instead.**
- **Motion discussed, Motion seconded, and passed.**
- **This is to be added to our 'Safety Document' and will be published.**

- **Administrative Insert:**
  - **During the meeting on July 13<sup>th</sup>, the request to affix officer signatures for Interim Chairman and Interim Deputy Chairman with the Interim Secretary for approval after the assembly was shown for approval.**
  - **This was agreed to by the Interim Chairman and Interim Deputy Chairman.**

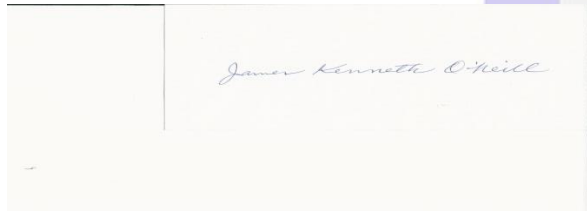
