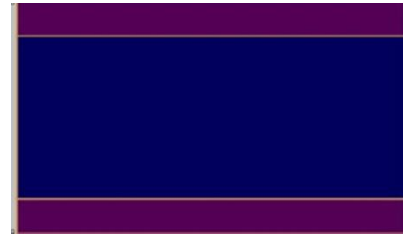

Denouncement of the Roosevelt Pledge

It all started when Franklin D. Roosevelt (Roosevelt) used his office and political party to establish a new timeline under a new religion which was intended to establish a New Order defined as a subsidiary of a Global Nation known as a New World Order. Many people have read the New Deal speech, but they never really read the speech. The last paragraph says it all.

“I pledge you, I pledge myself, to a new deal for the American people. Let us all here assembled constitute ourselves prophets of a new order of competence and of courage. This is more than a political campaign; it is a call to arms. Give me your help, not to win votes alone, but to win in this crusade to restore America to its own people.”

After FDR's third and fourth years in office, the Court, in a series of decisions that often broke down on 5-to-4 or 6-to-3 lines, invalidated high-profile New Deal bills, such as the National Recovery Act and the Agricultural Adjustment Act.

The decisions met with scorn from both FDR and from the liberal press nationally. After FDR's overwhelming reelection in 1936, the issue of handling the Supreme Court became one of his leading domestic priorities.

The Supreme Court (1935) held the New Deal unconstitutional in part because Congress violated the separation of powers by bestowing the president with the legislative authority to pass codes "he thinks may be needed or advisable for the rehabilitation and expansion of trade or industry." In addition, the Court found that the New Deal violated the Commerce Clause of the US Constitution because it regulated the hours and wages of employees engaged in intrastate commerce. The Court rejected the government's argument that remedying the financial crisis caused by the Great Depression called for an unconstitutional expansion of power.
