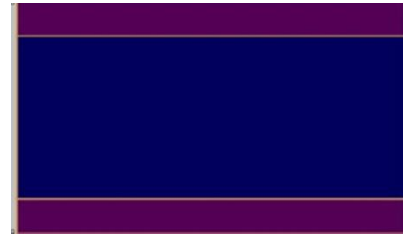

Discussion on the floor wherein the State of Florida constitution was being observed and for the ANU to make laws as to assist to maintain consistency within the respective States constitution wherein anything repugnant to those States constitution, respectively, null and void and to eliminate as much corruption and criminal activity from arising within the States of the Union of The United States of America whereby the American Nationals and Declared Residents in their respective States may maintain the internal security as such for a growing Nation in harmony to pursuit for a perfect perpetual union.

1. Looking into the State of Florida Constitution, Article 5, Section 3; The ANU needs to make laws for judges on what they can do and what they cannot do.
