GOVERNORS PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, The National Government of the State of Texas recognizes the Most High and the Creator to be one and the same; and

WHEREAS, Scripture clearly states that the Most High created the earth and gave dominion, including the herbs of the field to mankind, for the benefit and enjoyment of mankind and for the benefit to our health; and

WHEREAS, Governmental entities, corporations, special interest groups, and organizations have determined for themselves that they have the authority to overrule the actions of the Creator and that they have the authority to legislate, prohibit, license, and restrict the cultivating, growing, consumption, use of, transportation of, and control of herbs and vegetation naturally provided for mankind by the Creator, including herbs with known health benefits and natural healing properties, for their own benefit and profit; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned entities continue to impose the aforesaid legislation, prohibitions, and restrictions, on the naturally provided herbs and vegetation, and continue to trespass against the rights of people to cultivate, grow, consume, use, transport, and enjoy the gifts provided them by the Creator under threat of harm, incarceration, and other penalty. I therefore must take immediate action to protect the people of the State of Texas and the rights of the people of the State of Texas from further harm being caused within the metes and bounds and seaward boundaries of the State of Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, David L. Edwards, by the authority vested in me by the people of the State of Texas, the Constitution, and the laws of the State of Texas hereby find that, absent the measures set forth in this proclamation, The usurpation of the authority of the Creator and direct efforts to control the availability and access to the gifts given by the Creator described in section 1 of this proclamation would be detrimental to the people of the State of Texas and a violation of the rights of the people of the State of Texas to use and enjoy the gifts given to the people. I therefore hereby proclaim the following:

Section 1. Usurpation of the Creator and Restriction on Nature for Profit. The practice and implementation of restrictions on nature by actions of Governmental entities, corporations, special interest groups, and organizations which have determined for themselves that they have the authority to overrule the actions of the Creator and that they have the authority to legislate, prohibit, license, and restrict the cultivating, growing, possession, consumption, use of, transportation of, and control of herbs and vegetation naturally provided for mankind by the Creator, including herbs with known health benefits and natural healing properties, for their own benefit and profit is hereby prohibited, subject to section 2 of this proclamation.

Sec. 2. Scope and Implementation of Prohibition on Restrictions of Nature. (a) The prohibition on restrictions of nature and gifts given to man by the Creator pursuant to section 1 of this proclamation shall apply to all governmental entities, corporations, special interest groups, and other organizations operating within the metes and bounds and seaward boundaries of the State of Texas effective upon the date of this proclamation.

Sec. 3. Severability. It is the intention of the National Government of the State of Texas to enforce this proclamation to the maximum extent possible to advance the interests of the people of the State of Texas. Accordingly:

(a) if any provision of this proclamation, or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance, is held to be invalid, the remainder of this proclamation and the application of its other provisions to any other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby; and

(b) if any provision of this proclamation, or the application of any provision to any person or circumstance, is held to be invalid because of the failure to follow certain procedures, the relevant executive branch officials shall implement those procedural requirements to conform with existing law and with any applicable court orders.

(c) Enforcement of this proclamation, in addition to other efforts previously identified, will include the enforcement of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the UNITED

STATES Department of Defense, Military tribunal and War Crimes Tribunals consistent with international law accordingly.

Sec. 4. General Provisions. (a) Nothing in this proclamation shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

(i) the authority of a parent or guardian to decide what is in the best interests of their child or persons under their guardianship; or

(ii) the functions of the Judicial Branch of the National Government of the State of Texas, or officers, agents, contractors or representative employed to enforce legislation and laws governing import and export or control of the borders of the State of Texas.

(b) This proclamation shall be implemented consistent with applicable law, including international law, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and The Law of Armed Conflict.

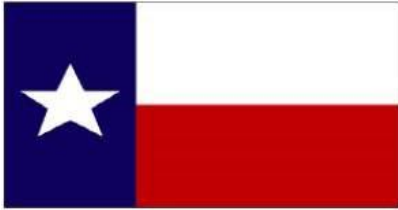
