- **Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams – Quorum Status**

- **Interim Secretary – John Adams – Yes, there is a quorum, please start the recording.**
  
- **Interim Secretary - John Adams – A Quorum is formed. Welcome to an official meeting of The Great Council of the ANTU, a sub-union of the American National Union of The United States of America. Our business office hour meeting began at approximately 8:24 pm EST. or 7:24 pm Central – UTC-6, to allow the assembly to gather into our Zoom conference room. After the meeting has ended and recording is turned off, we will take questions, so write them down or put in chat if you desire. You can raise your hand in the chat room and you will be recognized by the Secretary to the floor. When finished lower your hand. The hand is at the bottom of whose present in the room if you are new.**

- **Interim Secretary – Opening comments from Interim Officers. Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer.**

**Interim Chairman – Sean Beller:**

- **Shared screens to show latest update to ANTU safety document version three.**
- **All on the call were able to see the combination of documents to be put into one by John Mark Adams,**

**interim secretary. Each one was able to comment, ask questions, and help make changes where needed.**

- **Sean Beller made a motion that we pass what is in front of us and take to the National Assembly and the ANU. No objection and motion passed and carried.**
  - **Insert: On 4/22/2019 Sean Beller called interim secretary John Mark Adams to point out some changes that needed to be made in the Hold Harmless document. Changes were made to #2 for a spelling error, #5 about legal and lawful, and #6 about legal and lawful. During the 04/27/2019 official ANTU meeting the assembly wanted to make sure the terms 'legal and lawful' were carefully gone over by the National Assembly and the PAGAA before implementing document.**

**Interim Deputy Chairman – James O'Neill:**

- **Follow-up on outreach letter. John Mark Adams made the exact change in the letter James had. There is a letter specific and generic.**
- **James asked if our signatures can change to Script Cursive for better readability and make them not bring so much notice.**
  - **John Mark Adams put forth a motion to make the interim signatures script cursive. The other interim officers agreed to have all signatures changed to script cursive. No objections and the motion carried and passed.**

- **Another motion was made by John Mark Adams on behalf of James O'Neill to now send out the outreach letters with signatures that just passed.**
- **No objection and the motion passed and carried.**
- **Discussion was held to use the specific letter as needed and use the generic where applicable.**
- **Beth Cornett, from the assembly, asked for an overview of the Outreach.**
- **James O'Neill explained that intention.**
- **James O'Neill made a motion that all officers be allowed to open an account at Linked-In. No force of this motion to each officer holder.**
- **Sean Beller made a motion to ask James O'Neal to create an ANTU link on linked in and Mark Fain is asked to create an ANTU Facebook page.**
- **John Mark Adams added that the motion include business type things only with no arguments to create or follow any.**

- **The ANTU now will hear from interim treasurer Mark Fain.**
  - **Mark comments that on the immediate horizon there will be a conference call on the new fractional software.**
  - **It will be for the oils, and go straight into the banking area at that point. The label and logos will be going onto the product.**
  - **There will two sub-lingual, a topical, which is the CBD oils, and one other product.**
  - **As well, the plan is to convert to the convertible currency. Mark tells us that in about a week this project will begin to have legs.**
  - **Mark also tells us that these industries will be very fast growing and be able to co-mingle the inter-changeable currencies. There will be a hemp product involved as well. These products will come from the west coast and North Carolina. It will give the trucking industry a great opportunity to bring this to market.**
  - **At a certain point all will learn of this and be able to participate in the products. This is for anyone in business and The United States of America.**
  - **There will be training and vetting period before it goes live.**

- **Sean Beller makes a motion that the software will have to be approved through Genoa Holdings, PMA before it goes forward for public use. Mark Fain agreed. Mark said he has been in talks with Genoa Holdings, PMA. Discussion was held, no objections and motion passed and carried.**

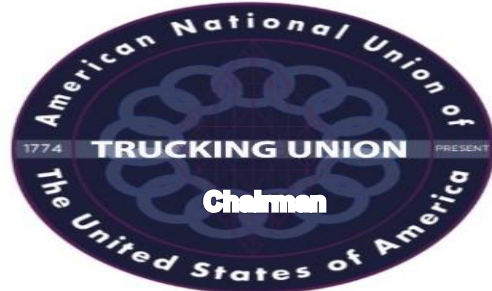
