- **Interim Deputy Chairman – James O’Neill – A Quorum is formed. Welcome to an official meeting of The Great Council of the ANTU, a sub-union of the American National Union of The United States of America. During announced discussion time on each point of order and after the meeting has ended and recording is turned off, we will take questions, so write them down or put in chat if you desire. - **Interim Deputy Chairman – James O’Neill**

- **Interim Officer Holder reports:**
 - **Interim Secretary – John Mark Adams, Trustee:**
 - **ANU Liaison needs to be decided on**
 - **Neal Cornett was elected and back up is James O’Neill for ANU Liaison. Neil agreed.**

- **Interim Chairman – Sean Beller:**
 - **Sean presented the opportunity for ANTU to handle the commercial vetting & suspension of license for this area.**
 - **One of the reasons is that drivers would get their License suspended and go to another state to get one.**

- **There would have to be a reciprocal agreement between the State Governments to do that.**
- **This is to be presented to the ANU for their OK in connection with ANU Transportation Administration.**

- **Beth Cornett states that the States can adopt the process for Transportation if desire or have reciprocity with the ANU Transportation Administration.**
- **The ANU is now able to take what The Government of The United States has used in Transportation and change it to the ANU wording.**
- **Danny Barron states a computer base would need to be available to track this type of information.**
- **Sean Beller says that it should be at a National level to help control it.**

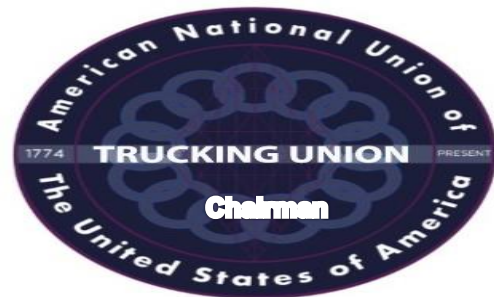
